5.	Essential Qualification	1 st class Master’s degree in Statistics/ Bio- Statistics/ Population Studies/ Information Technology/Computer Science/Computer Application from recognized university with 2 year experience in related field.
6.	Desirable Qualification	Experience of statistical software such as SPSS, STATA; knowledge/ experience of software for analyzing quantitative data. Publications in peer reviewed journals in the area of maternal or child health (MCH) or women’s health project work in MCH;
7.	Duration of post	30.09.2020 upto (Extension of the post will depend on the extension of the project).

The Terms & Conditions for the post are as follow:

1. The post is to be filled up only on purely temporary basis and will be for the duration of the project.
2. The appointment can be terminated with one month notice from either side without assigning any reason.
3. Since the post is purely temporary, the candidates selected will have no claim for regular appointment under ICMR or continuation of his/her services in any other project.
4. Benefits of provident fund, HRA, CCA, Leave Travel Concession, and Medical etc. are not applicable.
5. No. TA/DA etc. will be given to attend written test / or interview or joining of the post and candidate should make his/her own arrangement for stay and travel.
6. Experience will be counted only after completion of essential educational qualification.
7. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
8. The selected candidate will work in the project mentioned above, and on any other work that may be assigned by the Programme Officer from time to time.

9. If 30 or more than candidates attend the walk-in- interview, than written test would be conducted before the interview.
10. Candidates should bring the following documents for walk-in- interview.

 - b. Documentary proof of Date of Birth.
 - c. Experience Certificate from previous and current employer.
 - d. Certificate of essential qualification and desirable qualification.
